In order to provide a safe, comfortable and enjoyable environment for our residents, we work in partnership with healthcare providers and local businesses. As well as ensuring everyone gets the medical care they need, we're keen to make sure being one of the family at Engelhard Lodge is fun and rewarding. That's why we ensure there's always a wide range of activities and social events to choose from.

Healthcare

All our residents have unique health and care needs. We treat everyone at Engelhard Lodge as an individual to ensure their specific health issues are managed proactively.

We provide access to a myriad of healthcare services, including:

We enjoy an excellent working relationship with private and public healthcare providers. And our partnership with local NHS service providers is collaborative and highly effective. We facilitate GP visits at our Covidsafe care home, but we can also arrange for our residents to attend appointments at local clinics and surgeries.

If your loved one is registered with a GP in the Cawston catchment area, you're welcome to retain their services. However, we can help you to organise registration with a new GP practice if you or your loved one is new to the area.

Hairdressers

We understand that many of our residents want to enjoy the luxuries of life they became accustomed to over many years. We're determined to encourage independence and freedom of choice at Engelhard Lodge, which is why we organise a weekly visit by a local hairdresser.

Individual appointments within the weekly visit window can be arranged with our care home staff. However, the cost of this service isn't included in our monthly fee and must be paid separately.

Chiropodists and Opticians

In keeping with our commitment to maintaining the independence and dignity of all our residents, we regularly invite chiropodists and opticians to visit our welcoming Residential Home.

Individual appointments with chiropodists and opticians can be arranged with our care home staff. However, the cost of this service isn't included in our monthly fee and must be paid separately.

Activities

We strongly believe in the power of socialising and having fun. It's essential for both the mental and physical well-being of our residents. That's why activities play a significant role in life at Engelhard Lodge Care Home

Our full-time Activities Coordinator is responsible for organising and delivering a busy calendar of activities every week. The most popular activities among our residents include:

Keeping Your Loved Ones Safe During These Unprecedented Times

Our Covid Action Plan

We have a designated visitors room which can be accessed from the outside to visit with loved ones in the privacy of their ventilated space where a visit, meals and family occasions can be booked.

We're proud to provide our residents, guest, and visitors with a Covid-safe environment. All of your care workers, managers, administrators and support staff have been double-vaccinated for Covid-19 in full accordance with the UK Government's vaccine mandate for all care home workers.

During these unprecedented times, the safety of our residents is our top priority. That's why we've implemented a stringent set of guidelines to ensure Engelhard Lodge is Covid-safe.

For your peace of mind, we have a thorough Covid-19 action plan in place to minimise the chances of infection.

- Sanitising stations
- Ventilation measures
- Appropriate use of PPE
- Continuous staff training
- A schedule of deep cleans
- Dedicated spaces for visitors
- Extra staff and hours devoted to cleaning
- Use of technology for online video calling
- Regular cleanliness and Covid audits by management
- Regular infection control using approved cleaning agents



While we will always do our best to allow visitors at Engelhard Lodge, the health of our residents will always be our priority. We regularly test our staff and residents for Covid-19, and we might have to temporarily suspend visits in the

case of an outbreak.

We ask that all visitors take responsibility for their Covid status before arriving. If you are presenting any of the known symptoms, you should arrange a PCR test and stay away from our care home until you have a negative result. If you test positive, we ask that you stay away until you're free from symptoms and have tested negative.

The most common Covid symptoms to look out for include:

- Fever
- Loss of smell, taste or both
- A new and continuous cough

As you'll appreciate, many of our residents have weakened immune systems. Covid-19 is a deadly infection for the elderly and people with underlying health issues. We respectfully ask you to bear this in mind before and during your visit to our designated visitors' area at Engelhard Lodge Care Home.

Our Head Chef is Dimitrios Damalitis, and he's passionate about the healing power of good food. That's why he meticulously plans his menus several weeks in advance.

Hot beverages with biscuits and cakes are served between 11:00 and 15:00.

Our team of skilled and experienced kitchen staff are available to prepare snacks throughout the day.

Birthdays

The kitchen staff prepare a birthday cake and a small gift for every resident on their birthday. You're welcome to organise a small birthday party for your loved one. And we can cater for the guests if prior notice is given. Birthday catering is available at an additional cost. Private use of our lounges can be arranged in advance.

Special Diets

Our kitchen team can accommodate any special dietary requirements. We offer allergenfree options for celiacs and people with food allergies. And we can cater for people on low-fat, low-sodium and pureed diets. We also invite dieticians to Engelhard Lodge regularly to offer dietary advice in line with a GP's recommendation.
